RESOLUTION NO. 58-2026

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE FULL SUPPORT AND ENDORSEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PINATUBO COMMUNITY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, FORMERLY KNOWN AS PATAL PINTO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, LOCATED AT SITIO DAYDAY, EASTERN VILLAR, BOTOLAN, ZAMBALES

Whereas, Section 17, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that the State shall recognize, respect, and protect the rights of indigenous cultural communities to preserve and develop their cultures, traditions and institutions, and shall consider these rights in the formulation of national plans and policies;

Whereas, Republic Act No. 8371, otherwise known as the Indigenous People's Rights Act (IPRA) of 1997, further reinforces the right of Indigenous Peoples (IPs) to equal access to various cultural opportunities, including the provision of basic education that is culturally responsive to their specific environmental realities;

Whereas, a significant population of IP children residing in the far-flung ancestral lands of Sitio Dayday, Barangay Eastern Villar face geographical, structural, and socio-economic hurdles in accessing everyday primary education due to their distance from existing lowland centers;



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Whereas, the formal establishment of the Pinatubo Community Elementary School – originally referred to as Patal Pinto Elementary School, represents an invaluable breakthrough in bringing localized, safe, and quality primary education straight to the heart of the IP community in Sitio Dayday;

Whereas, transitioning and officially recognizing this institution as Pinatubo Community Elementary School fosters deep civic pride, honors the geographical heritage of our cultural communities, and secures the required institutional backing, staffing and resource distribution from the Department of Education (DepEd);

Whereas, the Local Government Unit of Botolan firmly believes that providing an accessible, localized school environment protects vulnerable IP children from grueling commutes, lower dropout rates, and serves as an effective mechanism for social protection, poverty reduction, and inclusive growth in upland areas;

Now therefore, on motion of Hon. Eddie D. Daos, duly seconded by Hon. Jay T. Dilag, and approved by all the members in session assembled;

Be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Botolan, Zambales, to express its full support and endorsement for the formal establishment of the Pinatubo Community Elementary School (formerly known as Patal Pinto Elementary School) at Sitio Dayday, Barangay Eastern Villar, Botolan, Zambales.

Resolved further, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned offices and agencies for their information and appropriate action.

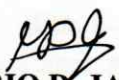
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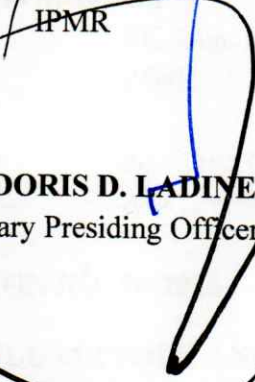
